Barruguet Festival – The Family Theatre

Taking place on the last weekend of May, the Barruguet Festival of Family Theatre will return once more to the Ibiza town of Santa Eulària in 2017.

Running from 26 – 28 May 2017, the festival will celebrate its fourth year bringing a range of family-friendly performances including street theatre, puppet shows, circus shows, animation shorts and traditional plays.

Last year's festival saw more than 50 performances from local theatre and entertainment groups, as well as theatre clubs and troupes from around the globe as well as the rest of the Balearic Islands, Catalonia and Valencia.

The main theatre performances take place at the Teatro España, a beautiful refurbished theatre in the town centre, as well as the Congress Centre. Many of the performances also take place outdoors on the streets of the town bringing the town to life.

Many of the shows including the street performances are free to watch, while prices will vary between €4-8 for other shows. A multi-show ticket can be bought for €50 offering access to ten shows throughout the weekend.

A park and ride system is also introduced during the weekend so that as many guests as possible can enjoy the festivities.

The festival hopes to entertain families, as well as inspire the next generation of children to be engaged and become involved with the arts and theatre performances. With many of the shows relying on visual performances, it's perfect for visiting families who do not need to worry about the language barrier.

Santa Eulària is ideal for families looking for a relaxing Mediterranean break. With family-friendly hotels, over 20 beaches including the first smoke-free beach in the Balearics, a range of activity options such as watersports, hiking and cycling, and delicious Mediterranean cuisine, the area showcases a different side of Ibiza for adults and children to enjoy in 2017.

The festival is organised in collaboration with the National Institute of Performing Arts & Music and the Ministry of Culture, Education and Sports.
