Santa Eulària des Riu, one of Ibiza's five regions, has announced its calendar of events for April and May 2018. From aspiring athletes to kids who love performance and nautical enthusiasts, there's something for everyone this Spring in Santa Eulària.

Ibiza Marathon, 7th April 2018

Spring 2018 sees the second annual Ibiza Marathon. The race takes place at sunset and thousands of runners will be able to enjoy 42,195 metres of Ibiza's countryside, starting off from Santa Eulària des Riu.

Santa Eulària Nautical Show, 27th-29th April 2018

Taking place at Santa Eulària Leisure Marina, this nautical show is a must for all those who love sailing as it features a wide variety of new and second-hand boats, displayed both on land and in the water. There will also be a selection of boating and other accessories relating to marine activities.

May Festivities, 5th-6th May 2018

One of the region's most important calendar events, during May, there are 15 days of festivities which feature a broad range of sports, culture and fun for the whole family. The main celebration takes place on the first Sunday in May (6th) when a long procession of carts decorated in flowers and ribbons and carrying local people wearing traditional dress travels through the streets. There is also folk-dancing, a procession of vintage cars and motorcycles, as well as concerts and flower shows.

Children's Theatre Festival Es Barraguet, 24th-27th May 2018

The 'Barraguet' is the name of a mythical mischievous character who is indigenous to Ibiza. Every year on the fourth weekend of May, this Children's Theatre Festival takes place inspired by this playful character, with the aim of encouraging children of all ages to enjoy a whole range of theatre styles, including circus, puppetry and dance!
